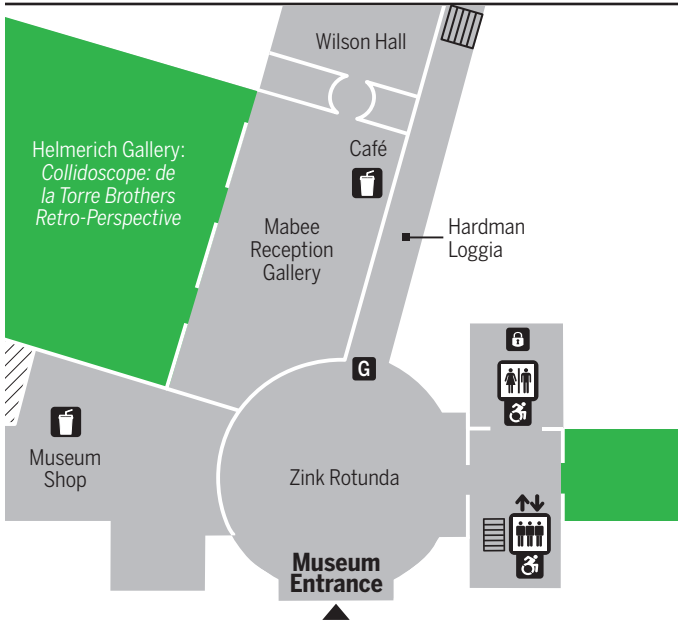

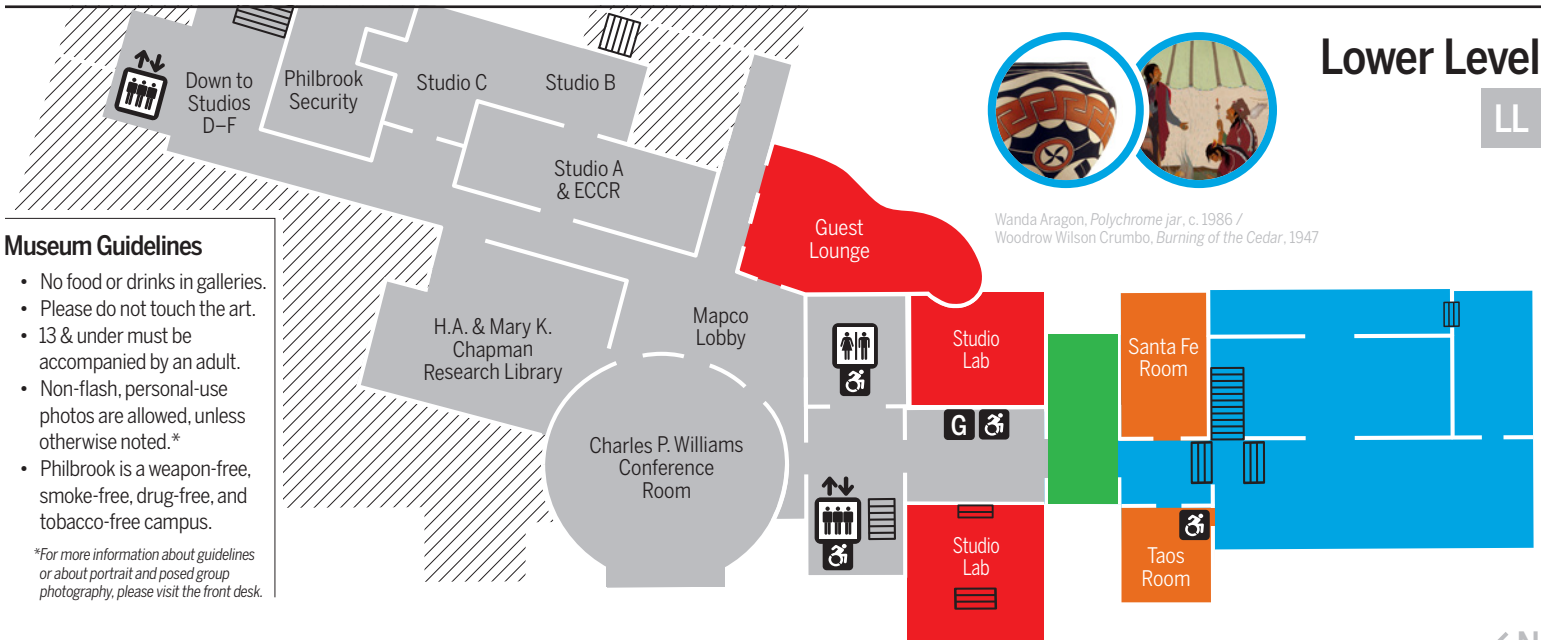

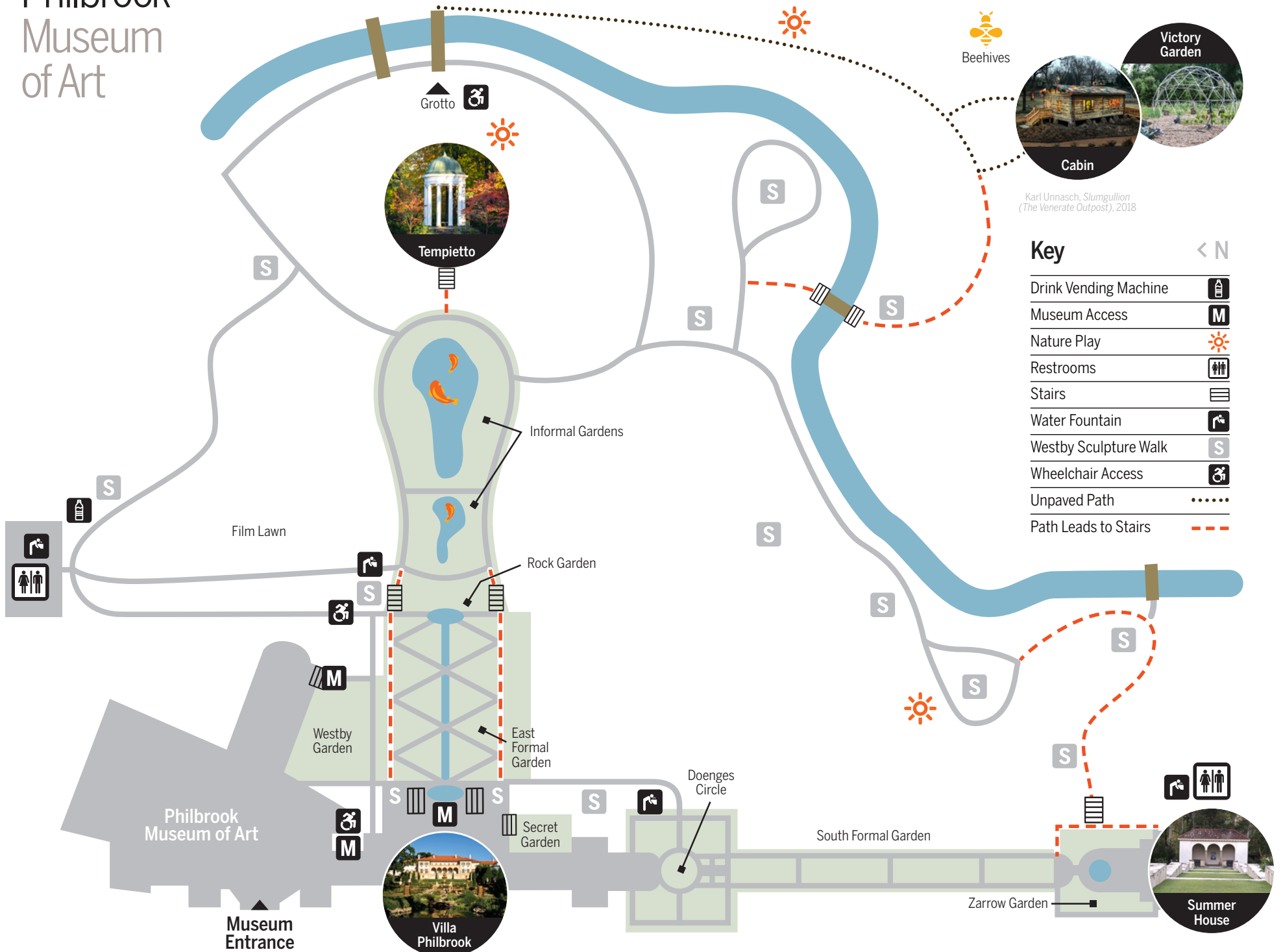
- No food or drinks in galleries.

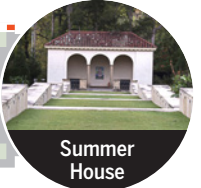
